Great emphasis is placed on strengthening research and educating young people, preparing them for active participation in society as well as making their mark on the global community. Currently some 13,000 students are enrolled at the University, including almost 1,400 international students.

The University of Iceland comprises five schools and 25 faculties offering over four hundred different programmes of study. It is the only university in Iceland

offering undergraduate and graduate programmes in all major academic disciplines, including doctoral degrees in most fields of study.
