## University of Iceland Graduation Ceremony 27 June 2020


### Dear Candidate,

### Useful information for the Graduation Ceremony

**Time and place:** 27 June, 10 am in Laugardalshöll

**Arrival:** No later than 9 am

### Health and safety is a priority

#### Emphasis is placed on health and safety at the Graduation Ceremony with regard to infection prevention.

- Laugardalshöll will be divided into two areas marked A and B. Staff will direct candidates to their designated seats.
- Candidates from the School of Health Sciences will use entrance A.
- Candidates from the School of Engineering and Natural Sciences will use entrance B.
- Keeping a two metre distance is optional and there will be a special area with two metres between seats for those who wish to do so.
- Only candidates will be able to attend the ceremony in person this year, but it will be live streamed here: <https://livestream.com/hi/brautskraning2020>

#### Seating

##### arrangements:

You will have a designated seat; your seat number can be found on the list of candidates by the entrance to Laugardalshöll.

##### The Ceremony:

When your group (i.e. department/programme) is called up, candidates walk onto the stage from the left to a mark on the floor. Once you have received your diploma from the Head of Faculty and been congratulated by the Rector, walk across to the right of the stage and return directly to your seat.

**University staff will be on site to assist and provide further instructions.**

**Please also inform your Faculty Office if you wish to maintain two metres distance from others.**
