

Guest Lecturing and Staff Training Mobility

Grant amounts by country: Maximum grant is for 14 days (including travel days). Subsistence grant is based on the agenda in the signed Mobility agreement and one or two travel days. The planned programme must last for minimum two days and include at least 8 working hours, except in the case of incoming guest lecturer from the world of work in Europe. Then the minimum stay is one day and at least 4 working hours.
